### What is the training about?

The training will help individuals and organisations who work with people living in the Northumberland Park area of Haringey to gain a better understanding of the Section 21 evictions process.



### As a result of attending this course you will:

- ◇ Understand what a section 21 eviction notice is and what it really means,
- ◇ Be able to identify some of the pros and cons of challenging a landlord's claim for a possession order,
- ◇ Understand some of the reasons why a tenant may be able to challenge a landlord's claim for a possession order,
- ◇ Be able to identify sources of information and legal help available to help tenants facing eviction from their home.



### Who should attend?

This course is aimed at intermediaries - individuals and organisations who work with people living in Haringey's Northumberland Park wards such as tenants' support organisations, faith organisations, women's support groups, local community groups, mental health workers, local advice agency staff and volunteers, local councillors and anyone who regularly helps people in the Northumberland Park area with S21 evictions.
