What is the training about?

Some residents of Northumberland Park ward face No Recourse to Public Funds (NRPF) restrictions. This session will help supporting organisations and individuals understand how to use the law to help them.



In the training session you will learn how to:

- ◇ Use the Children Act 1989 to help 'no recourse' families;
- ◇ Use the Care Act 2014 to seek support for 'no recourse' adults;
- ◇ Help 'no recourse' young people leaving care to access local council and other support;
- ◇ Help asylum seekers to access Asylum Support;
- ◇ Help victims of trafficking access local council and other support.



Who should attend?

This course is aimed at intermediaries - individuals and organisations who work with people living in Haringey's Northumberland Park wards - such as refugee organisations, faith organisations, asylum seeker support groups, community groups, local advice agency staff and volunteers, local councillors and anyone who regularly helps people in the Northumberland Park area subject to 'no recourse to public funds' restrictions.



Who will deliver the training?
